This will also include our local study as we have local links to support our learning.</p> <p><b><u>Egyptians</u></b></p> <p><b><u>What did the Ancient Egyptians achieve?</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Theme – Religion and Civilisation</u></b> An exploration of one of the earliest civilisations and their achievements, including where and when the first civilizations appeared.</p>
	Year 4	<p><b><u>The Roman Empire</u></b></p> <p><b><u>How did the Roman Empire impact Britain?</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Theme – Governance</u></b> An exploration of the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain.</p>		<p><b><u>Ancient Greeks</u></b></p> <p><b><u>How did the Ancient Greeks achievements influence the Western World?</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Theme – Civilisation</u></b> A study of the Ancient Greeks, their achievements and the influence they had on the Western World.</p>
